Report of the Facilities Provided

The college implements continuous tree plantation and conservation programs. Tree plantation programs are carried out during the monsoon season. The institute tries to inculcate the importance of tree plantation. Water conservation work is carried out in the vicinity to raise the level of drinking water by building forestry dams through the concept of Pani Adwa Pani Jirwa.

To save energy (electricity), the college uses LED bulbs and tubes, so energy is saved and bills are reduced. At the same time, instructions have been given to the students to save electricity. All are instructed to switch off lights and fans when the class leaves the room and when the professors leave the department and the non-teaching staff leave the office, and everyone follows these instructions strictly, thus saving electricity.

The college has provision of ramps for the disabled, along with wheel chairs. A barrier-free road is also made for the convenience of the disabled. There is no need to queue up for admission for disabled students. Also they are fully supported in the library by providing textbooks and competitive exam guidance books.

Wet Waste :-

Students and professors have to dispose of the wet waste in the college because if it is not cleaned on time, bad smell spreads and mold develops. For this, a separate kundi (garbage box) has been arranged in the college and the wet waste is thrown in it.

Paper waste:-

To avoid paper waste, the college always uses one side blank paper. It uses one side blank paper for various purposes. By using blank paper in this way, this waste is minimized.

The old newspapers and waste papers are collected together by the college and in case of excessive cancellation, they are scrapped after quotation or sold to scrap dealer.

Waste from trees:-

The waste accumulated from trees are kept at the bottom of the trees which keeps the trees and plants moisturized which saves water which also reduces soil erosion.

In addition, by collecting this litter and sprinkling it with dung water, it is decomposed and manure is produced from it and the same manure is returned to the same trees and the trees are rejuvenated.
